

## Hart County Board of Commissioners Called Meeting Wednesday November 27, 2019 1:00 PM

The Hart County Board of Commissioners met November 27, 2019 at 1:00 p.m. in the Hart County Administrative & Emergency Services building.

Chairman Joey Dorsey presided with Commissioners Frankie Teasley, Marshall Sayer, Ricky Carter present. Commissioner RC Oglesby was not in attendance.

Chairman Dorsey called the meeting to order and stated it was a Called Meeting not an Emergency Called Meeting. Chairman Dorsey stated item 3 was removed and set-back variance for permit 6201 was added.

Commissioner Sayer moved to approve the agenda as amended and Commissioner Teasley provided a second. The motion carried 4-0.

## 1. Statewide Mutual Aid Renewal

Administrator Partain explained the Georgia statewide mutual aid and assistance agreement must be approved every ten years; with the last agreement being in 2010. Commissioner Teasley moved to approve the agreement. Commissioner Carter provided a second to the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

- 2. Appointment of County Legislative Coordinator (CLC) Administrator Partain explained the ACCG's request to approve a resolution designating a county official or staff person by the Board of Commissioners to serve as the County Legislative Coordinator. Commissioner Teasley moved to designate the County Administrator. Commissioner Carter provided a second to the motion. The motion carried 4-0.
- 3. Speed Limit Ordinance Removed from the agenda.

4.	Set-back	Ordinance	Variance

Chairman Dorsey explained the County Set-back ordinance for buildings was originally grandfathered to mirrored the Corp of Engineers' requirement. Chairman Dorsey stated building permit 6201 would be approved as a matter of clarity by the present Board of Commissioners, with all future buildings to be individually granted a variance if requested. Commissioner Sayer moved to approve Steve Clements' requested variance. Commissioner Teasley provided a second to the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

Commissioner Teasley moved to exit into Executive Session to discuss personnel. Commissioner Sayer provided a second to the motion. The motion carried 4-0.
