Hart County Board of Commissioners met with Representatives from the City of Canon, City of Royston and the Town of Bowersville Tuesday June 23, 2026 at 5:00 pm at the Emergency Services and Administration Building.

Chairman Marshall Sayer presided with Commissioners Frankie Teasley, Jeff Brown and Joey Dorsey in attendance. Commissioner Michael Bennett was absent.

Canon Mayor Eli Brown, Royston Mayor Jason Phillips and Royston City Manager Lanier Dunn were in attendance.

Chairman Sayer called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone.

County Administrator Terrell Partain presented the numbers of how the TSPLOST would be divided among the County, City of Hartwell, City of Canon, City of Royston and Town of Bowersville.

Mayor Eli Brown of Canon asked the Board for an increase in the percentage of TSPLOST to pave dirt roads due to an increase in population on those roads.

Chairman Sayer stated that with this TSPLOST the County will not be paving dirt roads, they will be maintaining exist roads.

Commissioner Dorsey noted that residents purchased property on the dirt roads with that knowledge, and that if the City paved its portion, the County would need to pave its portion as well.

Commissioner Bennett and Town of Bowersville Council Member Matthew Butler arrived at 5:45.

City of Canon, City of Royston and the Town of Bowersville agreed to the allocations presented.

Commissioner Brown moved to move forward with the numbers presented for the TSPLOST. Commissioner Teasley provided a second. The motion carried 5-0.

Commissioner Dorsey moved to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Brown provided a second. The motion carried 5-0.
