Chairman Joey Dorsey presided with Commissioners R C Oglesby, Frankie Teasley, Marshall Sayer and Ricky Carter in attendance.

1. Approve Agenda

Commissioner Sayer moved to remove item 12 a) Tax Resolution Tax Year 2017 and approve the agenda. Commissioner Teasley provided a second to the motion. The motion carried 5-0.
