TOWN OF BOWERSVILLE  
2021 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

Notice is hereby given that a General Election shall be held for the **City of Hartwell** for the office(s) **Mayor** and **City Council** and **Town of Bowersville** for the office(s) of **Town Council**. The election will be held on **November 2, 2021** for qualified voters.

Qualifying for the municipal election shall be held at Hart County Board of Elections and Registration, 182 Cade St., Ste. B, Hartwell **August 16-18, 2021**. Hours of qualifying will be from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. each day.

Those qualifying for the position of **Hartwell Mayor**, to succeed Brandon Johnson, shall file a Notice of Candidacy and pay a qualifying fee of **\$360**.

Those qualifying for the position of **Hartwell City Council** shall file a Notice of Candidacy and pay a qualifying fee of **\$288**. Such Notice of Candidacy required filers to designate whether the candidate seeks the position of Member of Council currently held by Tray Hicks, Arthur Craft, or Patrick Guarnella.

Those qualifying for the position of **Bowersville Town Council** shall file a Notice of Candidacy and pay a qualifying fee of **\$15**. Such Notice of Candidacy required filers to designate whether the candidate seeks the position of Member of Council Post 2 currently held by Felicia Brown, or Post 3 currently held by Cindy Hensley.

All persons who are not registered to vote and who desire to register to vote in the special election may register to vote through the close of business on **October 4, 2021**.

Early voting will be held at 182 Cade Street, Ste. C, Hartwell, **October 11-29, 2021**, 9am-5pm., Monday-Friday.

Appropriate polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Should a runoff election be required, such runoff will be held on **November 30, 2021**.
