

The Hart County Fire Board met on Monday, February 7, 2011 at 6:30 P.M. at Station 1 with the following members of the Fire Board present, David T Ray, Mike Milford, Tom Murphy, Joseph Haley, Jerry Byrum, David Lorentson, Alan Daniel, Stephen Ayers, Marshall Norton and others.

Marshall Norton called the meeting to order.

The ISO Board met with the Hart County Fire Board to discuss working on getting the ISO rating lowered for Hart County. Plans are to get equipment inventory from each station and to meet at the next Fire Board meeting.

Agenda was approved. Motion made by Joseph Haley and seconded by Mike Milford. Yes carried the vote.

Minutes of the January 5, 2011 meeting was read and approved. Motion made to approve by Mike Milford and seconded by Joseph Haley. Yes carried the vote. Chief Byrum stated that a draft copy of the minutes will be posted at each station.

Captain's report:

Chief's Report:

Do not call 911 and say you are standing by at the station.

Use the chain of command with question or problems.

Chief Byrum is planning to appoint Jeff Purcell as Training Captain if he will accept it.

Need inventory of all equipment on each truck.

Discussed the Station response districts. Marshall Norton made a motion to let Jerry Byrum and Alan Daniel decide on the districts and David Ray seconded it. Yes carried the vote.

Joseph Haley made a motion that the Assistant Chief cannot serve as a captain in the Fire Department. David Lorentson seconded it. After some discussion, Marshall Norton made a motion to table that till the next Fire Board meeting. Stephen Ayers made the second and yes carried the vote.

Alan Daniel reports the following:

Gave each station Firefighter Recertification Core Competency Task Book.

On March 5th, there will be a Mayday class at station #1 at 8 a.m. and a live burn at 1 p.m.

On March 12 there is a hasmat class at station #1 and on March 19, the fireman can take the State test for the hasmat class.

On April 30th, the Firefighters game will be held and all stations are encouraged to participate. Gave out guild lines to follow on the different games that will be going on.
