Advance/in-person early voting starts in Hart County **TOMORROW** → Friday, March 28th and will run through Friday, April 11th for the Special Election Run-off. The regular election date for the Runoff is set for Tuesday, April 15th. As a reminder, this run-off election is to fill the vacant District 2 County Commissioner seat.

Only registered voters within the county's District 2 area are eligible to vote for this commission seat.

Voters may check their registration status by visiting www.sos.ga.gov on the internet. Click on "Elections", then click on "Voter Information." "My Voter Page". Follow the instructions to view your personal voter information."

The Board of Registrars office will be open daily during this time period from 8am – 5pm, **including** lunch hour of Noon – 1pm.

Please be advised our office location is no longer in the Courthouse. We moved last year to our new address at 182 Cade Street, Suite B, Hartville, GA, which is directly across the street from the old hospital's location. We again plan posting directional signs to our location, as well, to help voters locate the office.

There will be no Saturday voting, during this Early Voting Run-off session, since no federal offices are included on this ballot.

Our office is already accepting Absentee Ballot applications. You may request them either via e-mail, telephone, FAX, or in-person at our new office. Mail out of Absentee Ballots will commence once the printed ballots have been received, reviewed, and delivered to our office.
