

This meeting was called to order at 11:00 A.M. by Elizabeth Forbes, Chief Registrar. At the commencement of this meeting Chief Forbes thanked all for attending. Hilda Mauldin had missed the previous meeting due to health concerns. Chief Forbes commented on how well she looked and how nice it was to have her back involved in the office operations.

1. Reviewed reports for months end April 2012
2. A Hearing was held to remove 16 deceased Hart County voters.
3. A discussion was held regarding the upcoming VRAG Conference in Savannah, GA, June 3rd thru 6th. Hilda Mauldin and Ron Walker have graciously stepped aside from their rotational right to attend the conference to allow Chief Forbes and Clerk Stephens to attend in their place. One full day of the conference will include demonstrations and discussions with regard to the new voter registration system. This is a critical learning issue for the Chief and the Clerk.
4. The upcoming Absentee and Early elections were discussed with regard to the estimated number of mail-out ballot voters (including UOCAVA) and in office voters. Supply orders for this Primary Election can be placed on E-Traker on May 14th thru 25th only. Clerk Stephens will make sure we are well prepared with labels, envelopes, forms, etc. The General Election turnout number expectations were discussed as well. Chief Forbes will be preparing the work schedule to cover the Primary election period for both mail-out ballots and in office voting.
5. Open discussion included the upcoming weeks work schedule. Clerk Stephens had requested a shift in schedule to allow her to visit family out of the Country. Chief Forbes and Board Member Mauldin kindly offered their assistance.

With no further discussion this meeting was adjourned at 11:57 A.M.
