Please help keep the meals rolling at the Hart County Senior Center.

Did you know that just 30 minutes of your time, once a week, can help feed Hart County's homebound seniors? We currently have over **35** homebound seniors on the Meals on Wheels **waiting list**. We have funds available to feed these seniors, but not enough volunteer drivers to deliver the meals.

Substitute and **regular drivers** are needed on weekdays. A typical meal route only takes about **30 minutes**. You could volunteer as much or as little as you like. The majority of volunteers commit to 1 weekly or 1 bi-weekly route. The meals are packed and ready to go when volunteers arrive around 10:45 AM, Monday - Friday.

Meals on Wheels volunteers touch the lives of seniors through time and service. Make a difference by brightening their day, showing them that people care, and by **ensuring them one hot meal a day**. Sadly, our volunteers are usually the only people these homebound seniors get to see each day.
